To Commemorate the Closure of the Adelaide Street Tram Services 50 years ago

Will be running a Bus tour along some of the old Northside Tram Routes on **Sunday 2nd December 2018** departing 12.15pm from Roma Street, using QOCS Leyland Panther buses that was used as tram replacement.

The tour will start at 1215pm at the bus stop outside Brisbane Police HQ, 200 Roma Street, Brisbane opposite Roma Street Transit Centre.

The tour will follow outbound along Rainworth Tram Route, inbound along Bardon Tram Route , outbound and inbound along Chermside Tram Route , inbound along Stafford Tram Route , outbound along Grange Tram Route and city by Adelaide, George and Roma Street and outbound along Enoggera Tram Route. Whilst travelling these routes a full presentation will be supplied by a Tram Museum member about interesting points along each route

After reaching the Old Enoggera Tram Terminus at about 3.15pm, the bus then continue on to the Brisbane Tramway Museum where you will be supplied with Afternoon Tea and an escorted tour of the museum and free tram rides until 4.50pm.

The Bus will depart the museum at 5pm and return you to Roma Street Transit Centre at about 5.30pm
